### JESUS' CONCEPT OF THE FATHER: Hugh Lynn Cayce

From the perspective of the Edgar Cayce readings, what did Jesus think about His Father? When we come to this concept of Jesus, we discover, of course, that He said, "I and my Father are one." The oneness is established there.

It is important for us not to just get caught up in the words, but having read the words, begin to back up and try to understand them through experiencing their meaning. Intellectually, we can build barriers to an understanding of these concepts. So, instead, try to look toward experiencing the oneness of God, and not just intellectually grasping it. It is possible for you and me to experience oneness—

not intellectually but the movement of consciousness.

First, we will build these concepts from the readings, and then you're going to need to work with them in your meditations, in your dream experiences, in your relations with one another, in your groups, in your families, and with the people you work with and pray for and who pray for you, because you will begin, then, to sense this oneness of experience. In a way, what's going to happen is that you're going to fall in love with everybody—even the ones who really are a little too much for you. That's what it's all about.

“Know, O Israel, the Lord thy God is one.” All power, all force, is a manifestation of that which is termed God consciousness. This quote runs throughout these readings, surely Jesus talked again and again about this oneness with His Father.

The concept is the oneness of all force is a difficult one to grasp. The first principle of oneness we need to work with is this: our mental, physical, and spiritual bodies are all one. We’ve got strange attitudes about our bodies and about ourselves. It’s hard for us to believe that this body that we think has caused us so much trouble is one with our mental and spiritual bodies. We think of the flesh body as a weak and lowly thing, desiring everything that has gotten us into so much trouble. We think that just as soon as we can get out of it

and take off into the universe everything will be fine. Nothing could be further from the truth! You and I are going to be around until we get this body straightened out. There isn’t any use talking about going anywhere until then.

The real physical body, however, is one that is vibrating a little faster than this flesh body, but it is still atomic in its structure. It is one which has the out-of-body experiences, the one we inhabit as soon as we die. It is a physical body and is involved in all of those desires. It is the one that has gotten us involved in matter and is the one—the part of us—that suffers a bit now. This body must be seen as part of the whole. The physical body, the mental body, and the spiritual body and all one.
